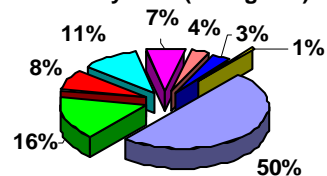

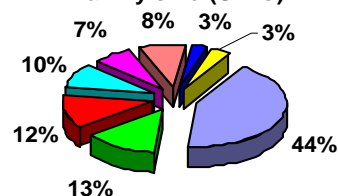

Family size (Refugees)



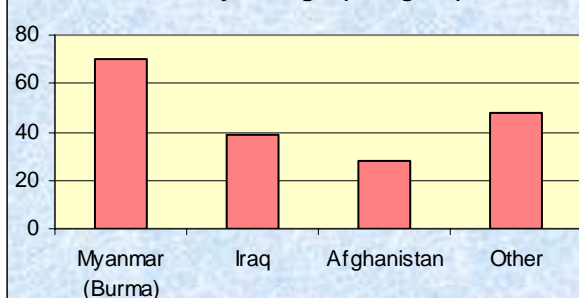

Family size (SHPs)



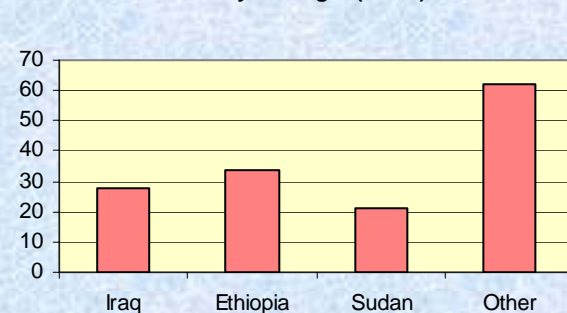

Country of Origin (Refugees)



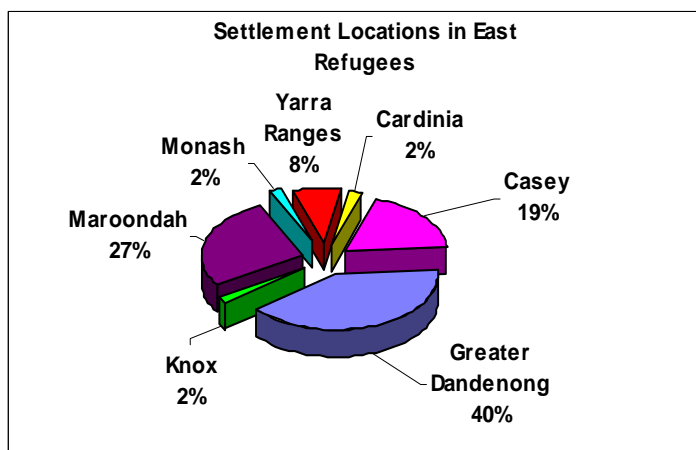
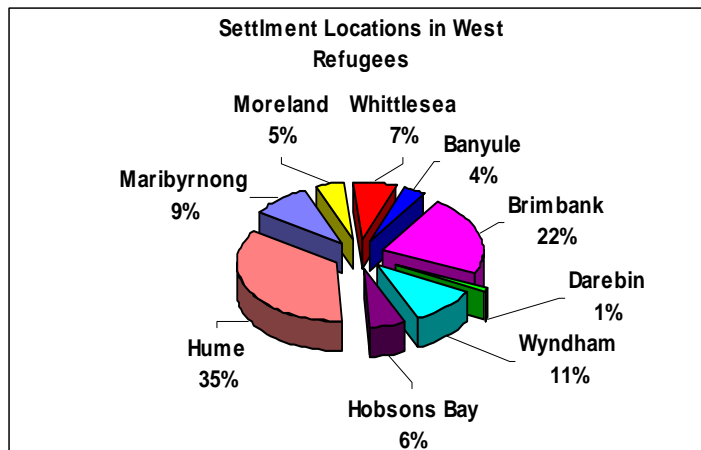

Country of Origin (SHPs)



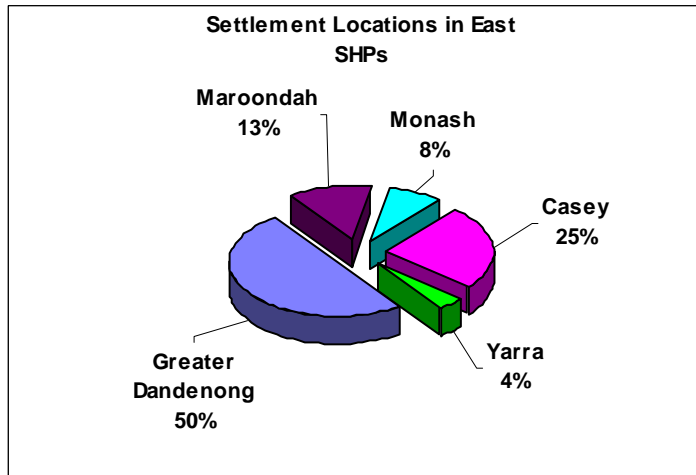
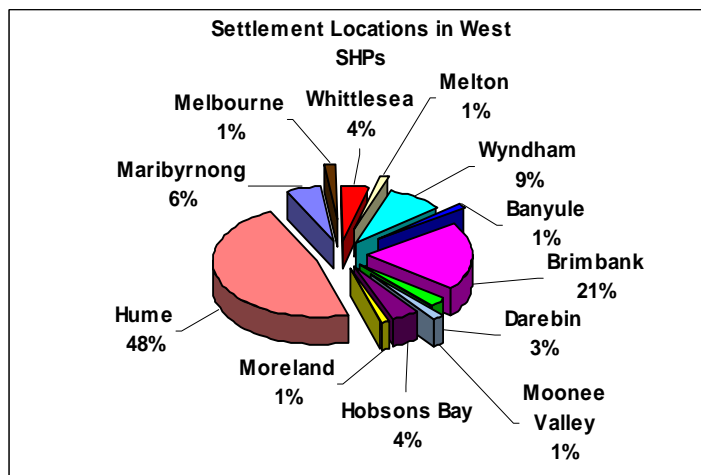
