Program of activities


Throughout the year the hub runs a range of activities including:

At the hub, people can meet up and work, share, and learn in a safe and supportive environment.

Commercial grade community kitchen

Our fully functional kitchen is available for community groups and not-for profit agencies to hire. Features include three mobile benches with stove tops which can be set up for training purposes, commercial grade oven with six burner hob and industrial dishwasher.

Used in conjunction with adjacent meeting spaces, the kitchen is ideal for preparing regular meals for community gatherings.

Shared office facilities

Office hot desk facilities are available to small community groups who may want a central office base but are willing to share.

Ideally suited to groups who need an office space just a couple of each days each week, our hot desk arrangement means you can have a computer workstation to access on a regular basis together with file storage and access to a photocopier, fax and other office facilities.



Who can use the hub?

Anyone can use the hub, but priority is given to: not-for-profit multicultural community organisations and their members, especially those living in the City of Melbourne municipality. Other groups we encourage to use the hub include: established migrant groups residing in the City and across Melbourne and regional areas, new and emerging humanitarian communities, Indigenous communities, international students and multi-faith networks.
