

WAGE SUBSIDIES	 Wage subsidies are to be used only for employment which is sustainable and ongoing after the wage subsidy has ceased. Up to 80% of the Wages or Salary Only consider upgraded hours in the 80% calculation – if job is an Upgrade Additional employment costs such as superannuation, insurance etc should not be included in this calculation. If above 80% of the Wages or Salary, DEEWR Approval is required Value of the wage subsidy must be appropriate to job seeker's level of disadvantage 			
	Wage Subsidies CANNOT be:			
PROHIBITED WAGE SUBSIDY SITUATIONS	 In excess of 100% of the wage costs Paid to/or for positions with AMES Consortium Used for short term and seasonal positions that do not lead to sustainable employment Used for family members of the employer Claimed or reimbursed in advance for the period covered by the wage subsidy Used for self employment Used for, positions with Commonwealth or State Government departments or agencies Note: wage subsidies for employment in local government councils or in ancillary services such as school canteens which is not funded by the Commonwealth or State/Territory Government, may be paid for through the EPF

REGISTRATION	Car registration can be purchased for jobseekers with supporting justification
